

## **The Poole Volunteer Programme**

Role title:	ALDP Live Helper Volunteer
Purpose:	Live Helper is a free, secure and confidential online support service provided by Ana Liffey as part of drugs.ie offering information on drug and alcohol issues. The role of the Live Helper Volunteer is to participate in the staffing of the Live Helper service and ensure efficient service delivery. The Live Helper volunteer role is to respond to individuals who may be coping with a range of stressors relating to their own or a loved one's drug or alcohol use. This role therefore requires a sensitive and informed response to support those contacting the service.
	The main tasks of the role are:
	To provide drug and alcohol-related information
	To act as a signpost to services
	To provide support
	To provide information on the continuum of substance use, including dependency/addiction
Where:	The volunteer will source the location where the Live Helper role is carried out and use their own PC. This location will be agreed with the Ana Liffey and should be confidential, comfortable and secure without any external distractions.
When:	Saturday & Sunday from 12:00 to 24:00
Time requirements:	2 hour commitments during hours: 12:00 to 24:00 Schedules can be accommodated for weekly or monthly commitments. We ask that volunteers commit to work for a minimum of 12 months
Duration:	3 months' probation, with a review at the end of the first 6 months.

Must have a degree in psychology, addiction studies, social sciences, teacher training or equivalent.
Be comfortable in an online environment
Have excellent written communication skills
Be able to work on their own initiative
Be able to commit to 5 consecutive weekends of training
To work well as part of a team
The ability to understand confidentiality and sensitivity as they apply to the role
Must be at least 23 years old
Must be able to understand, communicate and uphold ALDP regulations.
Must demonstrate compassion and a non-judgmental approach towards those contacting the service.
Desirable attributes
Experience working in the field of addiction and or homeless services would be an advantage.

We intend to expand the service to an out-of-hour's service during the weekend between 12 noon and 12 midnight on Saturdays and Sundays.  The Live Helper role functions as  Substance use and addiction support. Information provider. Signposting service.  Help us to increases our capacity to work with more clients.
Orientation and training:	Volunteer Induction to ALDP Active listening training Drug and alcohol information training Local and National services signposting and orientation around drugs.ie and ALDP websites. Orientation around the live helper software. Simulation of Live Helper with role play and script review. Orientation covering emergency procedures, ALDP policies, resource management, and service tour. Opportunities to be part of ALDP training and education programmes throughout the year.
